

Minutes for October 2003 Meeting
of the Aiken County Republican Party

The regular monthly meeting of the Aiken County Republican Party was held on Thursday, October 9, 2003, at the Aiken County Council Chambers. The following officers were present:

Chairman David Nix welcomed everyone to the meeting, saying that it would be the Precinct Reorganization Make-Up Meeting [to reorganize precincts that had not reorganized on Tuesday, September 23]. He called on Susan Swanson to offer the invocation and lead in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman David Nix:

- * Recognized the following elected officials:
 - * Jim Sutherland, Mayor of New Ellenton and
 - * Dick Smith, Aiken City Councilman.
- * Said that approval of the minutes from the September 2003 meeting would be postponed until a quorum of County Executive Committeemen was present.
- * Read that the Treasurer's Report showed a balance of \$3,053.58 and expenses for the period September 1, 2003 through September 30, 2003 included payment for renewing the registration of the party's domain names.
- * Moved away from the podium to distribute Precinct Reorganization materials to those who had not previously reorganized and to allow reconvening of reorganization meetings that had been recessed.

After receiving back all of the Precinct Reorganization materials that had been distributed, Chairman Nix:

- * Declared, "We're done,"
- * Talked with a few folks privately about details concerning the County Convention, but made no announcement about event details at the podium, and
- * Left the room.
