

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the Tenth Amendment states that the federal government has no power other than that delegated to it by the states via the Constitution; and

WHEREAS the U.S. Congress is the law-making branch of the federal government; and

WHEREAS it is unconstitutional for the Congress to delegate its law-making power to the Executive branch and/or to independent agencies; and

WHEREAS Article I, Section 8, Sentence 5 states that only Congress has the power "To coin Money, regulate the Value thereof, and of foreign Coin, and fix the Standard of Weights and Measures"; and

WHEREAS a President must adhere to these constitutional principles in order to obey his oath of office;

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Aiken County Republican Party Executive Committee urges that all Republican presidential candidates strictly adhere to all the constitutional principles listed above.

This resolution was presented at the August 9, 2007 meeting of the Aiken County Republican Party. A motion was made and seconded to pass the resolution as written by the Executive Committee, a quorum being in attendance, and it passed.
